Can I use studded winter tires?

Can't I just get two winter tires?

While winter tires may contribute, the effect is minimal; a decrease in gas mileage often has more to do with winter gas, which has special additives that affect engine performance. Roof racks and ski boxes add aerodynamic drag; these can also affect gas mileage.

Can I drive my winter tires all year round?

Using winter tires year round is not recommended.

Modern winter tires may wear unneces-sarily quickly, particularly on coarse spring roads and on hotter summer roads. The wear may be uneven as well. Many tire dealers offer storage for off-season tires, making seasonal tire changing easy for drivers.

When should I put on my winter tires and when should I take them off?



Winter Driving Poses Special Challenges

(NewsUSA) - Car owners might maintain their vehicles to avoid paying more in fuel costs, but regular maintenance also means safer winter driving. A summer breakdown proves inconvenient, but mechanical problems on icy roads can be deadly.

The experts at the non-profit National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), which formed in 1972 to improve automotive service and repair, offer motorists the following checklist to ensure safe driving this winter:

- Read your owner's manual, and follow the service schedules.
- Get engine driveability problems, like hard starts, rough idling and stalling, corrected at a good repair shop. Cold weather will make existing problems worse.
- Replace dirty filters, including your air, fuel and PCV filters. Change your oil and oil filter as

specified in your manual -; more often if your driving is mostly stop-andgo or consists of frequent short trips.

- Flush and refill your cooling system as recommended. Check the level, condition and concentration of the coolant periodically. Never remove the radiator cap until the engine has thoroughly cooled.
- Leave some jobs to the experts. A certified auto technician can check the tightness and condition of drive belts, clamps, and hoses. ASEcertified technicians pass strict tests to prove their expertise and wear blue-andwhite ASE shoulder insignia. For more information, visit www.ase.com.
- Make sure the heater and defroster are in good working condition. A failed heating system will leave passengers cold, while a broken defroster can dangerously reduce visibility.

- Hire a technician to check your battery. Only professional equipment can detect weak batteries. Wear eye protection and rubber gloves when cleaning off corrosion.
- Worn tires slip easily, making vehicles more likely to skid. Examine tires for remaining tread life, uneven wearing and cupping, then check the sidewalls for cuts and nicks.
- Check tire pressure once a month. Let the tires "cool down" before checking the pressure. Rotate as recommended. Don't forget your spare, and be sure the jack is in good condition.
- Have your vehicle's exhaust system examined for leaks. The trunk and floorboards should be inspected for small holes. Exhaust fumes can be deadly.
- Keep a blanket, shovel, flares and some high-energy snacks in the vehicle just in case. And don't forget your cell phone.

- Rear cross traffic alerts that warn drivers if traffic is approaching from the left or right when the vehicle is in reverse

signal is not activated.
