Cheese Blintzes

original recipe makes 8-10 servings

- 1 (1 lb.) loaf white bread
- 4 tablespoons white sugar
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 2 (8 oz) packages cream cheese, softened
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1 pint sour cream



Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Spray a cookie sheet generously with non-stick cooking spray. Trim crusts from bread and roll the slices flat. In a small bowl combine sugar and cinnamon to make a mixture. In a large mixing bowl, mix softened cream cheese, milk and vanilla until smooth. Spread this mixture onto each slice of flattened bread. Roll each bread slice up. Dip bread/cream cheese rolls in melted butter, roll the blintzes immediately in the sugar-cinnamon mixture. Cut rolls into 1 inch pieces. Arrange the blintzes on the prepared cookie sheet. Bake for 10 minutes. Serve with sour cream.

BBQ Quesadillas

original recipe makes 4 servings

- 1/2 pound boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 3 (1/2 inch thick) slices peeled cored fresh pineapple
- 1 cup KRAFT Creamy Mexican Shredded Cheese with a TOUCH OF PHILADELPHIA, divided

- 4 medium potatoes, peeled and cut into large chunks
- 1 medium red bell pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 clove garlic, sliced
- 1/2 cup dry bread crumbs
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- paprika to taste
- salt to taste
- ground black pepper to taste



Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. In a medium baking pan, toss together the zucchini, potatoes, red bell pepper, garlic, bread crumbs, and olive oil. Season with paprika, salt, and pepper. Bake 1 hour in the preheated oven, stirring occasionally, until potatoes are tender and lightly brown.
