Save Lots of Money with Proper Boat Maintenance

after 59 years of being in business, that people do not do preventive maintenance on their boats and motors like they should. There are a few things a person can do, that over the lifetime of their boat, could save them a lot of money.

I have found,

In the winter time, people do not winterize their motors and lower units. They leave water in the gear case and in the motor causing major damage. When water is

left in the motor it freezes and cracks the block. Spending \$200 to have it properly winterized could same you any where from \$2,000 to \$6,000. Water freezing in the lower unit can break it, as well. A \$100 service could save you \$500 to \$1,500 on a repair job.

Oil is the lifeblood to an outboard motor. Using outboard manufacturer's motor oil could save you thousands of dollars on a rebuild.


Manufacturer's oil has special ingredients to lubricate decarbonized motors. A lower unit should have the oil checked and changed at the end of every season.

People will sometimes run their boats out of the water causing the shortening of the life of the impeller. A \$150 repair can save you thousands of dollars on a rebuild.

Before storing your boat for the winter be sure to put a good gas stabilizer in the gas. You should add it to the fuel the last time you use your boat before you pull it out of the water so that the gas with the stabilizer gets into the whole fuel system protecting the fuel pumps and carburetors.

Boats stored for a long time should have the batteries removed. The batteries should be charged and their water checked before storing. You should also have your prop removed to make sure there is no monofilament





around the prop shaft. Also, check your charging circuit to make sure it's not overcharging. If your motor is overcharging it burns up the batteries and boils out the water.

You should also have the spark plugs pulled out and checked. A technician can look at how a spark plug is burning and see if there is a problem about to occur to your motor. You can

see clean burning and oil burning. At the same time, a boater can run the compression check and a spark check to see if the motor is in good condition, both mechanically and electrically.

Water pump impellers on some motors should be serviced yearly. On older Mercury outboard's and I/O's the pumps fail more often, even if the motor is not used. The veins in the impeller

will take a set and reduce the flow of water from sitting still in the housing. A water pump job runs about \$125 and could save you thousands on a rebuild.

Use my information as a checklist for your boat and motor maintenance. It is better to spend your money upgrading your boat and motor than on repairs that could have easily been prevented. When summer

ends and you start to store your boat for next winter remember my years of experience and let that help you save lots of money.



Open all doors and compartments and check for rodent intrusion and water damage.

2. Replace any dry cell batteries you may have removed for winter storage.

Test the operation of the carbon monoxide detector, the LP gas leak detector and the smoke detector.

4. Check the fire extinguisher and make sure it is fully charged.

5. Open the awning to let it dry. If required, clean with awning cleaner, it cleans and adds a wax to help keep it clean.

Raise the radio / TV antenna.

Inspect all seams, windows and vents for water damage and reseal if necessary. Use correct products for sealing. Do not use silicone products, only items ment for RV's.

Lubricate all hinges and locks with spray lubricant.

Test the operation of the hydraulic jacks if applicable. Also check the hydraulic fluid level.

Place mothballs near (not in) the gas burner assembly of the refrigerator (to prevent spiders from nesting and causing gas flow blockages at the burner). Also cut fleas collars and place in compartments and refrigerator compartments. Suposedly wasps and other insects do not like the flea collars.

Place sheets of Bounce or Fleecy (or similar product) under each mattress and cushion. This will keep field mice away as they don't

like the smell.

12. Inspect the tires for signs of dry rot. Inflate all tires to the recommended tire pressure.

13. Inspect wheel bearings, brakes and suspension.

14. The Water System.

If you live in the colder climes, where annual winterizing with RV antifreeze is required, you must flush the system thoroughly before use to get rid of the antifreeze. While this antifreeze is non-toxic it tastes really bad. Flush the water system by following the steps below:

Fill your on board water tank 3/4 full and add one or two capfuls (not cupfuls) of household bleach. Take the unit around the block to slosh the mixture to all parts of the tank.

Turn on the water pump and open all taps one by one to allow this solution to fill every water line

and flush out the antifreeze. Once this is done, let it sit overnight.

Connect to your city water and flush every outlet for at least 5 mins. Now switch the water heater bypass to allow the water heater to fill. This procedure will prevent the antifreeze from entering the hot water system. While this is not a health problem, as such, the antifreeze will produce a foaming condition that can persist for several days.

Drain your fresh water storage tank and refill with fresh water. You can add a capful of bleach every time you fill the water tank to keep it fresh and sanitary. However, due to the unknown quality of campground water

supplies, and the fact that the water in your tank may stand for several days or weeks in the hot sun, it is recommended that you use bottled water for drinking supplies.

Now is a good time to check the

operation of your dump valves. The slide mechanism should operate smoothly with no sticking and should seal completely. Change any suspect valve before a problem develops. There are not many things worse that encountering a

stuck or broken sewage dump valve, when the tanks are completely full.

These are just a few items for taking care of your RV. If you are not sure of what to do or use, contact your local RV repair services.


