

JPHS Essay Contest High School history students in the Jackson Purchase Region of Kentucky and Tennessee are eligible to compete for awards and cash prizes by writing essays about national, regional, and family history in a contest sponsored by the Jackson Purchase Historical Society(JPHS) in conjunction with the Office of University Advancement and the Department of History of Murray State. Dr. Bill Mulligan, president of the Jackson Purchase Society, said "2018 is the beginning of the bicentennial for the treaty that established the Jackson Purchase and its also the 60th year of the founding of the Historical Soceity, which promotes interest in the history of the 12 counties involved. We saw this as a great opportunity to extend our outreach to high school history teachers and their students." History students in all four grade levels at high schools in the 12 counties that make up the Jackson Purchase, including Henry County, may submit essays in three categories: U.S. history, Jackson Purchase Regional History, or family history. History teachers at participating schools have the details on the essays. The deadline for submission is February 1 and there is no cost to participate. Judges will select winners in each category for each grade level with finalists receiving medallions and certificates. From those students, judges will then select the best overall essay in each category. The three winners will receive \$100 cash and will make a brief presentation on their essay at the April 2018 meeting of the JPHS. All three winning essays will also be published in the 2018 edition of Journal of the Jackson Pur-



Tuna Melt

- 25-ounce cans chunk light tuna drained
- 1 medium shallot, minced (2 tablespoons)
- 2 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon minced flat-leaf parsley
- 1/8 teaspoon salt



Preheat broiler. Combine tuna, shallot, mayonnaise, lemon juice, parsley, salt, hot sauce and pepper in a medium bowl. Spread 1/4 cup of the tuna mixture on each slice of toast; top with tomato slices and 2 tablespoons cheese. Place sandwiches on a baking sheet and broil until the cheese is bubbling and golden brown, 3 to 5 minutes.

Warm Snow Pea & Chicken Salad

1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breast, trimmed 1 14-ounce can reduced-sodium chicken broth

3 tablespoons rice vinegar

3 tablespoons reduced-sodium soy sauce

3 teaspoons toasted sesame oil, divided

Place chicken in a medium skillet or saucepan and add broth; bring to a boil. Cover, reduce heat to low, and simmer gently until cooked through and no longer pink in the middle, 10 to 12 minutes. Transfer the chicken to a cutting board to cool. Shred into bite-size pieces. (Cool and refrigerate the broth, reserving it for another use.) Meanwhile, whisk vinegar, soy sauce, 2 teaspoons sesame oil and tahini (or cashew butter) in a large bowl until smooth. Heat the remaining 1 teaspoon oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add ginger and garlic and cook, stirring, until fragrant, about 1 minute. Stir in slivered peas and cook, stirring, until bright green, 3 to 4 minutes. Transfer to the bowl with the dressing. Add the chicken to the bowl with the peas; toss to combine. Serve sprinkled with cashews.

Canola oil cooking spray 1/2 cup sliced almonds

1/4 cup whole-wheat flour

11/2 teaspoons paprika

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/2 teaspoon dry mustard

Preheat oven to 475°F. Line a baking sheet with foil. Set a wire rack on the baking sheet and coat it with cooking spray. Place almonds, flour, paprika, garlic powder, dry mustard, salt and pepper in a food processor; process until the almonds are finely chopped and the paprika is mixed throughou. Drizzle in oil; process until combined. Transfer the mixture to a shallow dish. Whisk egg whites in a second dish. Add chicken tenders and turn to coat. Transfer each tender to the almond mixture; turn to coat evenly. Place the tenders on the rack and coat with cooking spray; turn and spray the other side. Bake the chicken fingers until golden brown and crispy 20 to 25 minutes.

Combine peanut butter and pretzels in a small
bowl. Chill in the freezer until firm, about 15

sheet lined with parchment or wax paper and
freeze until very firm, about 1 hour. Roll the frozen
balls in melted chocolate. Refrigerate until the
chocolate is set, about 30 minutes.




