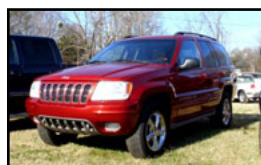

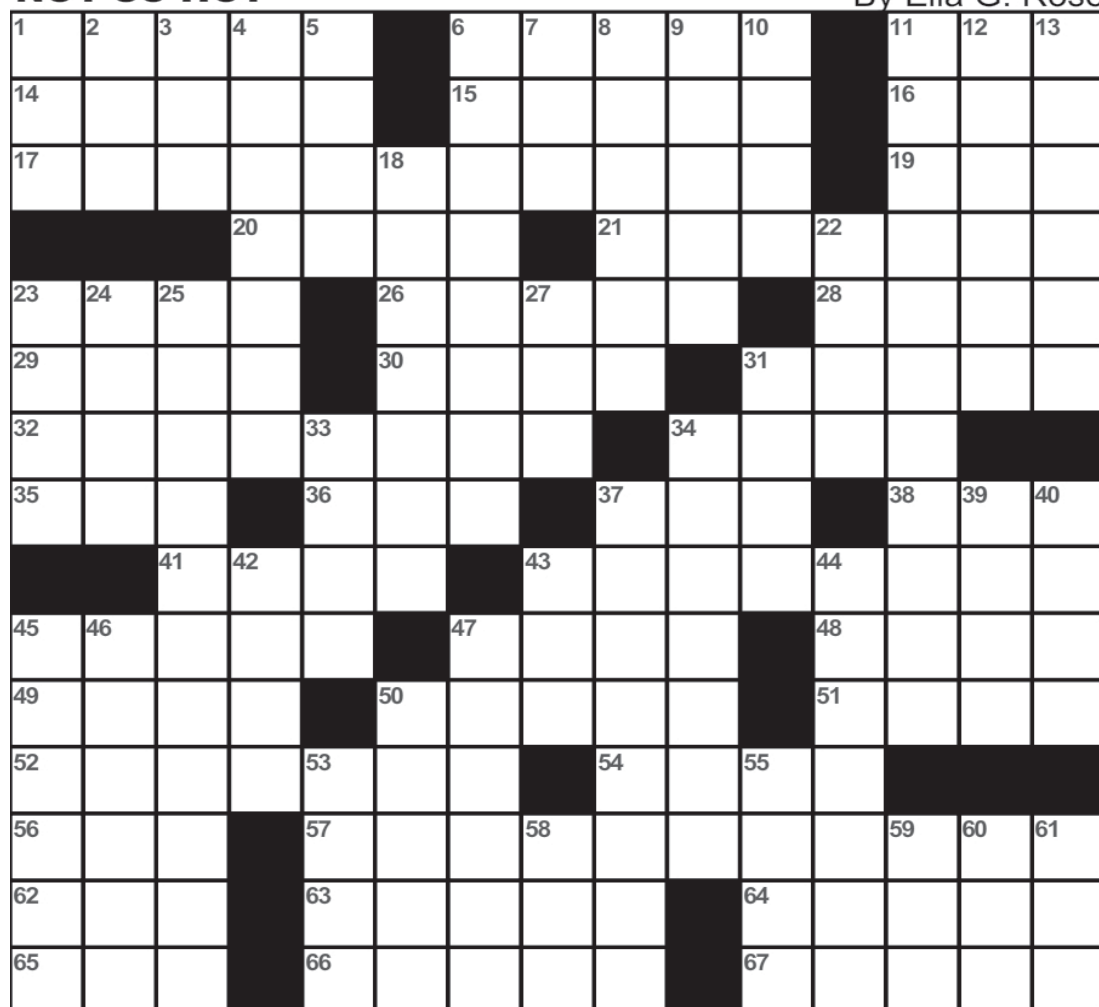

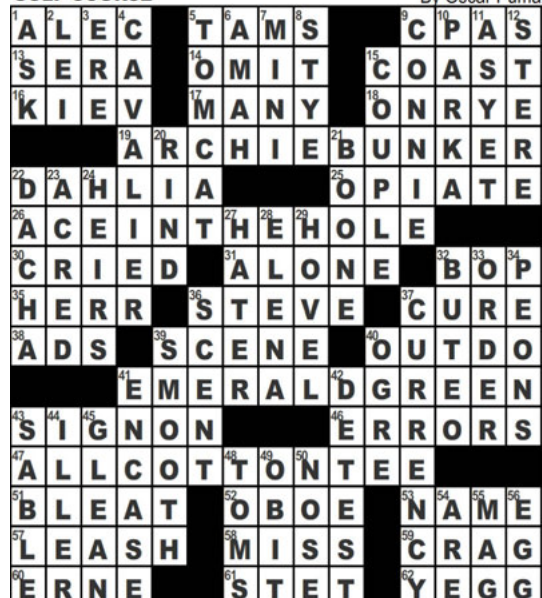

Candied Almonds

original recipe makes 2 cups

1/2 cup water
1 cup white sugar
1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
2 cups whole almonds



Combine the water, sugar, and cinnamon in a saucepan over medium heat; bring to a boil; add the almonds. Cook and stir the mixture until the liquid evaporates and leaves a syrup-like coating on the almonds. Pour the almonds onto a baking sheet lined with waxed paper. Separate almonds using forks. Allow to cool about 15 minutes.

Baby Back Ribs

Original recipe makes 4 servings

2 lbs. pork baby back ribs
1 (18 oz) bottle barbecue sauce
Tear off 4 pieces of aluminum foil big enough to enclose each portion of ribs. Spray each piece of foil with vegetable cooking spray. Brush the ribs liberally with barbecue sauce and place each portion in its own piece of foil. Wrap tightly and refrigerate for at least 8 hours, or overnight. Preheat oven to 300 degrees F. Bake ribs wrapped tightly in the foil at 300 degrees



F (150 degrees C) for 2 1/2 hours. Remove from foil and add more sauce, if desired.

Lemon Roasted Potatoes

original recipe makes 6 servings

1/4 cup canola oil
1/2 cup butter, melted
2 tablespoons lemon juice
3 cloves garlic, minced
1 tablespoon dried dill weed
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground black pepper
5 large potatoes, peeled and cubed



Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F. In a large bowl, stir together the canola oil, melted butter, lemon juice, garlic, dill, salt and pepper. Add potatoes and toss to coat. Spread the potatoes out on a baking sheet and drizzle any remaining liquid from the bowl over them. Bake in the preheated oven until potatoes are brown and crispy, about 45 minutes.

Raspberry and Almond Shortbread Thumbprints

original recipe makes 3 dozen

1 cup butter, softened
2/3 cup white sugar
1/2 tsp almond extract
2 cups all-purpose flour

1/2 cup seedless raspberry jam
1/2 cup confectioners' sugar
3/4 tsp almond extract



Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a medium bowl, cream together butter and white sugar until smooth. Mix in 1/2 teaspoon almond extract. Mix in flour until dough comes together. Roll dough into 1 1/2 inch balls, and place on ungreased cookie sheets. Make a small hole in the center of each ball, using your thumb and finger, and fill the hole with preserves. Bake for 14 to 18 minutes in preheated oven, or until lightly browned. Let cool 1 minute on the cookie sheet. In a medium bowl, mix together the confectioners' sugar, 3/4 teaspoon almond extract, and milk until smooth. Drizzle lightly over warm cookies.

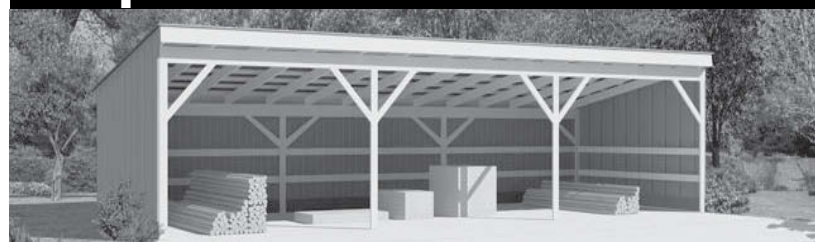

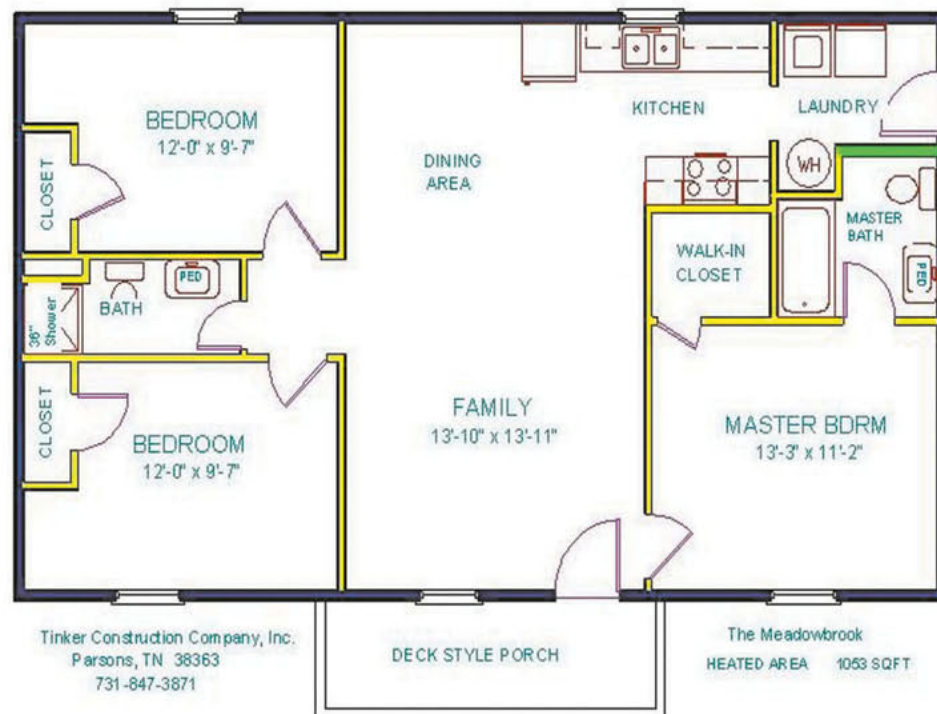
