



2 5-ounce cans chunk light tuna drained 1 medium shallot, minced (2 tablespoons) 2 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise 1 tablespoon lemon juice 1 tablespoon minced flat-leaf parsley 1/8 teaspoon salt

Preheat broiler. Combine tuna, shallot, mayonnaise, lemon juice, parsley, salt, hot sauce and pepper in a medium bowl. Spread 1/4 cup of the tuna mixture on each slice of toast; top with tomato slices and 2 tablespoons cheese. Place sandwiches on a baking sheet and broil until the cheese is bubbling and golden brown, 3 to 5 minutes.

# Warm Snow Pea & Chicken

Salad

- 1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breast, trimmed
- 114-ounce can reduced-sodium chicken broth
- 3 tablespoons rice vinegar 3 tablespoons reduced-sodium soy sauce
- 3 teaspoons toasted sesame oil, divided

Place chicken in a medium skillet or saucepan and add broth; bring to a boil. Cover, reduce heat to low, and simmer gently until cooked through and no longer pink in the middle, 10 to 12 minutes. Transfer the chicken to a cutting board to cool. Shred into bite-size pieces. (Cool and refrigerate the broth, reserving it for another use.) Meanwhile, whisk vinegar, soy sauce, 2 teaspoons sesame oil and tahini (or cashew butter) in a large bowl until smooth. Heat the remaining 1 teaspoon oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add ginger and garlic and cook, stirring, until fragrant, about 1 minute. Stir in slivered peas and cook, stirring, until bright green, 3 to 4 minutes. Transfer to the bowl with the dressing. Add the chicken to the bowl with the peas; toss to combine. Serve sprinkled with cashews.



**Almond Crusted Chicken** 

#### Fingers

Canola oil cooking spray 1/2 cup sliced almonds 1/4 cup whole-wheat flour

- 11/2 teaspoons paprika
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder 1/2 teaspoon dry mustard



Preheat oven to 475°F. Line a baking sheet with foil. Set a wire rack on the baking sheet and coat it with cooking spray. Place almonds, flour, paprika, garlic powder, dry mustard, salt and pepper in a food processor; process until the almonds are finely chopped and the paprika is mixed throughou. Drizzle in oil; process until combined. Transfer the mixture to a shallow dish. Whisk egg whites in a second dish. Add chicken tenders and turn to coat. Transfer each tender to the almond mixture; turn to coat evenly. Place the tenders on the rack and coat with cooking spray; turn and spray the other side. Bake the chicken fingers until golden brown and crispy 20 to 25 minutes.

#### Peanut Butter Truffles

1/2 cup crunchy natural peanut butter 1/4 cup finely chopped salted pretzels Combine peanut butter and pretzels in a small bowl. Chill in the freezer until firm, about 15 minutes. Roll the peanut butter mixture into 20 balls (about 1 teaspoon each). Place on a baking sheet lined with parchment or wax paper and freeze until very firm, about 1 hour. Roll the frozen balls in melted chocolate. Refrigerate until the chocolate is set, about 30 minutes.






