Homemade Flatbread

450g strong (baker's) flour (see note)
7g sachet dried yeast
1/2 teaspoon caster sugar
1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil, plus extra to serve
2 teaspoons zaatar, plus extra to serve (see note)
Preheat the oven to 200°C and lightly oil 2 baking trays. Sift the flour into a bowl and add yeast, sugar, oil, zaatar, 1 teaspoon salt and 1 cup (250ml) warm water. Stir to combine, then bring the mixture together with your hands and knead for 5 minutes until smooth and elastic. Divide dough into 4 balls. Roll the dough out on a lightly floured board into ovals. Place dough on baking trays and prick the surface with a fork. Bake for 5 minutes, then turn over and bake for a further 5 minutes or until golden and cooked through. To serve, brush warm flatbreads with oil and sprinkle with extra zaatar.

Strong (baker's) flour is available from supermarkets. Zaatar is available from specialty spice and Middle Eastern shops.

Store in Ziploc bags or large sealed bowl.



The World's Biggest Fish Fry has the distinction of being one of those events that covers every single aspect of what makes a great time in the south. You need good fried food, all






