For the Bassmaster High School Series event, the full field of anglers will compete Thursday June 22nd and Friday June 23rd, taking off from Paris Landing State Park Marina at 5:30am. Weigh-ins will take place at 1:45pm Thursday and Friday at Paris Landing State Park, then final weigh-in for the Top 12 teams will be at 2:30pm Saturday in downtown Paris. Fans can also follow along with the events thru B.A.S.S. on their website, Facebook, or Twitter.
