3. PREPARE YOUR PLOT OR POT

If planting inground, be sure to clear the area of previous planted crops and weeds, as they may decay and harbor bacteria. Always bag, tie and discard debris. Turn up the soil's top layer and add some bagged compost, and mulch. If planting in a pot, be sure to sanitize pots and use fresh, new potting soil,

specifically formulated for containers.

4. PROACTIVELY PATROL FOR PESTS

While pest numbers naturally decline in the cooler days of fall, they don't disappear entirely. Common pests of cool-season plants include tiny, sap-sucking aphids, caterpillars (particularly from cabbage white butterflies) and harle-

quin bugs. Inspect your plants for tiny clusters of aphids or tell-tale holes in the leaves. Handpick caterpillars or harlequin bugs from plants and dispose of them or use a strong blast of water from a hose to dislodge aphids.


5. EMBRACE COOLER, CARE-FREE COM-FORTS

With the warm days and cool nights of fall, less moisture evaporates from your garden or pots, so you'll need to water less often. (Only water when the soil 2" deep is dry.) 

"Graffiti," the city called it. "First Amendment!" countered homeowner Lubek

Yes, that's an extreme example of unintended consequences. But even though legally the homeowners wound up off the hook, anyone now contemplating shelling out significant bucks on home improvements should read on for some tips on avoiding costly missteps.

* Don't paint your house brown either. Since most people have it in the back of their minds that they'll eventually want to attract buyers other than those obsessed with









friend. It was two years ago that a noted design guru had this to say to the New York Times about online virtual reality, augmented reality, and 3D rendering tools: "It's definitely the wave of the future, because it allows the general population to make design decisions without feeling hesitant or insecure," said Khoi Vo, a profes-

Here's what to look for while you're up there:

- * Water leaks. As sure as tweeting at 3 AM is generally a bad idea, it will soon storm. And when it does, shine a flashlight up in the attic to check not only for dripping water and condensation, but also for water stains on the ceiling, walls and floors. All signal that H2O is finding its way beneath your roof's shingles or behind its flashings.
- * Ventilation. "Think of the attic as the lungs of the house," advises Joplin. "It has to be able to breathe in order to function properly." Which is to say, vents stuffed with debris need to be cleared.
- * Animal damage. You know those "If you see something, say something" homeland security ads? Well, to avoid the havoc refugeseeking birds,


bats, squirrels and raccoons can create, warning bells should likewise sound -- followed by a call to a pestcontrol pro -- if you spot any of these telltale signs: nests, droppings and gnawed wood, wires or insulations.

* Structural problems. The mere hint of a sagging roof -- look up for this one -- could indicate potential structural weakness requiring professional repair.


