





marks and footprints.

Concrete flooring offers soft and warm looks in muted grays, taupe and beige. Its versatility makes it complementary and adaptable to all kinds of interior settings.

Another trend is to mix contrasting materials such as wood and tile. Though not possible with the "real thing" due to wood's tendency to expand and contract, pairing wood and stone looks in porcelain creates a stunning effect. Tiles made to look like bricks are also popular. The laidback "loft look" in porcelain is much easier to maintain than the real thing. The most basic of shapes, the stripe, is also appearing in all categories of flooring, especially soft surface. It appears frequently in the form of striated rock looks in weaves; in porcemini finger tiles; and in vinyl, in looks that mimic linen, sedimentary rock and parquet. Carpet continues to get softer and more plush as technology advances. The latest look features layered color, soft texture and lots of dimension. Using another technique that combines both loops and sheared fibers, carpets are imbued with 3-D effects featuring multiple heights and colors ranging from subtle to bold.



Just like indoor lighting, outdoor

lighting is most effective if it utilizes overhead, task and ambient light sources. Even outdoors, where there are not typically boundaries and borders, those three layers will enhance enjoyment and help define smaller sitting and entertaining areas as though they are outdoor rooms.

in dark corners. Aim lights away from the door so as not to blind anyone as they enter your outdoor area.

Light walkways and paths with light that is cast downward and fixtures that are hooded. In many cases, exterior-safe dimmers and movable fixtures, which can be added to a patio or porch as needed, can provide flexible control over the level of light.

While functionality is the top priority, aesthetic elements are important for a relaxing and inspiring setting. Focus on lighting that highlights architectural and natural details, as well as other decorative elements like arbors, pergolas, patios, etc.

Conserve energy. Consider LEDs for their efficiency. Also think about Energy Star and Dark Sky fixtures that reduce glare and minimize light into the sky as well as neighboring yards and windows. Remember to check the color (chromaticity) of LED outdoor lights. Low chromaticity lights (2700 or 3000K) will look similar to incandescent and halogen bulbs. Higher chromaticity LEDs (4000K and above) will have a whiter, bluer look.

How to Store Your Warm Weather Gear for Winter Hibernation

Too soon, it will be time to put away your classic car, boat, motorcycle, and patio furniture, until warm weather arrives again.

Proper storage techniques are super important to keep your gear in great shape and running order. To make sure you are ready to roll next spring, we've compiled a list of simple storage tips:


Storing your classic car or

motorcycle. It's important to clean and remove all road grime, dust and other debris from all interior and exterior surfaces before storing. Then, after cleaning, make sure to protect hard surfaces and finished leather with 303 Automotive Protectant. Also, remember that old gas breaks down over time and can lead to gummed-up fuel

lines, carburetors and injectors. To avoid these issues, fill your fuel tank 95 percent full with fresh gas and add a quality fuel stabilizer such as STA-BIL Storage to keep the gas fresh for as long as 24 months. After the stabilizer is added, run the engine for a few minutes to ensure that the stabilizer gets into all parts of the fuel system.

Storing your boat and water equipment. It's best to do a thorough cleaning of your boat to avoid any deterioration while it sits in storage. Start by removing all the dirt and grime from the boat's surfaces with a cleaner such as 303 Marine Citrus Cleaner & amp; Degreaser, and protect the exterior of the boat with





303 Marine Quick Wax. Moving to the inside, similarly to the classic car, fill the gas tank 95 percent full with fresh fuel and add a fuel stabilizer. Store your boat in a cool, dry place and cover it to keep dust away.

Storing your small engine equipment. Most fuel available today contains ethanol,

Storing your patio furniture.


Dust. Mold. Mildew. Dander. Chemicals. What do all of these have in common? All of these are considered contaminant/ air pollutants. Everyday life of cooking, cleaning, walking in/out of the house can generate a great deal of air pollutants that are pulled into your HVAC system, recirculating 5 to 7 times a day on average, producing a build-up in your ductwork. Although filters are used, the heating and cooling system still gets dirty through normal use. The heating and cooling system is the lungs of your home, taking in air and breathing air out. In a typical six-room home, up to 40 pounds of dust is created annually though everyday living.

When cleaning the HVAC system it should be placed under continuous negative pressure with a truck mounted vacuum, allowing very fine particles to be removed from the system as they become airborne, preventing the spread of contaminants into the living space. A portable device is used to brush/

agitate the ductwork from inside the home while the truck mounted vacuum provides us with a way to remove contaminants, and debris directly from your duct, not through your home.

Having dirty ducts does not necessarily mean the air is unhealthy in your home, although they could be contributing to larger health issues or harboring contaminants. Someone that has severe allergies, respiratory, or autoimmune disorders would greatly benefit from having a Negative Air Duct cleaning. 



Is Your Money Going Up the Chimney? How to Make Your Fireplace More Efficient




