



HOUSECLEANING TPS Spring Up Your Home

It can be nice to finally get some fresh air after it starts cooling down outside, but wouldn't it be nice to have a home that looks and smells fresh too? • CHANGE YOUR AC FILTER. So many homeowners

· CLEAN THE REFRIGERATOR.

It's almost impossible to keep the refrigerator 100% clean. Make this into a habit and you'll save money & keep your fridge clean on a more regular basis. To save time, wait until you are about to go grocery shopping. Take a few minutes to remove as much as you can, discard old leftovers, out of date items, and then clean with

An empty fridge is not very efficient because every time the door opens it has to cool all the air down again. Consider putting some water bottles (of any kind) the fridge when you have extra space. These items will be stay cooled down as well as lower the

dish soap and water total volume of air then towel dry. If you have some get back down to stubborn areas simply combining and adding carbonated total volume of air and help the fridge get back down to the desired temperature much faster with less energy.

• FRESHEN UP THE DRAPES. While curtains can be a little more difficult to clean, simply remove them from the window, take off the hooks, throw them in the dryer with a moist towel, and run a light cycle for 15 minutes. As soon as they are done, hang them back up

right away.


· CLEAN THE

CEILING FAN AND CHANGE A FEW LIGHTS. Instead of using a duster, wipe them down with Murphy's Oil Soap and water. Don't use furniture polish, it will attract even more dust. While you have a ladder or stepstool out already; go ahead and take the time to change out your smoke alarm batteries, change out any bulbs that have gone out. You might want to switch to bright but low energy LED bulbs.

· PROFESSIONAL CARPET CLEAN-

using heavy-duty machines that are designed to pull out dirt and debris from the fibers. • WASH THE WINDOWS. In-

stead of using glass cleaner to clean the windows, use a towel and soapy water to remove all particles and smears. Be sure to wipe them down thoroughly with a dry towel to avoid leaving streaks behind. Have plenty

of towels and wipe off the frames and sills as you go.

•CLEAN THE SCREENS, you may need them to let some cool fresh air in during the coming Fall months. Get rid of the dust and debris from the screens by brushing them down with a soft brush. This way you can get in the tiny holes to remove the particles. If you have a small tear in them, you can pick up a patch kit at Lowe's or Home Depot.

· CLEAN TOUCH

POINTS. Use a disinfectant cleaning and a few moist towels with disinfectant to wipe down, light switches, door knobs, and doors themselves. Don't forget TV remotes, refrigerator handles, and other frequently used objects in your home. This will cut down on the spread of bacteria and may even keep members of your family from getting sick from flu and other seasonal illnesses.

• CLEAN STAIN-LESS STEEL. This kitchen material certainly provides a modern, luxurious

look to the home, but it's also easy to see every water mark and streak on the surface. Be sure to use a cleaner that is specific for stainless steel surfaces and wipe it down gently. If you have a problem with fingerprints try using rubbing alcohol with a microfiber or buffing towel. For best results buff in the direction of the grain.

• CLEAN THE SHOWER. The shower area in the bathroom can have build-up residue if it hasn't been regularly cleaned due to all number of summer activates. But instead of using a harsh chemical cleaner, fill a spray bottle with half water and half vinegar to spray on the surfaces, wiping them down with a scrub brush.

•CLEAN THE DISHWASHER. Do you have a slight



dishes, never stack them. Do not put too many utensils in the basket. If there is not space between the dishes, they are not getting cleaned properly. On pots & pans, most dishwasher detergents will cause pans to rust and coatings to come off, it is best to wash those by hand with dish soap and water.

· CLEAN THE **WASHING MACHINE.** This is another appliance that is often thought to clean itself, but if it smells musty, you can use vinegar, baking soda, and hot water to clean it and running it for out. Allow it to run a load of hot water first, and then add letting them sit for a half hour to hour. 





Mow

Grass continues to grow until the first frost, so it's important to keep mowing throughout the fall. Ideally, you should keep your yard at 2 1/2-3 inches in height, which is short enough to prevent matting and fungi like snow mold yet long enough to keep the root system deep enough to withstand the cold and dryness of winter. Leaving small clippings on the yard can also add organic matter, moisture and nutrients to the soil.



fertilizer from reaching the roots. The process of aerating removes soil plugs from the yard to encourage root growth and free up passageways for nutrients.

Rake

When leaves fall on your lawn, they can block out sunlight and, if left too long, stick together to form a suffocating mat on your grass, potentially leading to fungal diseases. Start raking as soon as leaves begin to fall or blow into your yard, and rake at least weekly. Alternatively, use your lawnmower fitted with a collection bag attachment For best results, to remove leaves from your lawn's surface.

Fertilize

Because grass grows slower as the weather cools, fall is the ideal time to fertilize. In midto-late-fall, apply

a dry fertilizer to your grassy areas to provide necessary nutrients and encourage deep roots and denser growth that can better compete with weeds and tolerate disease and insects. For optimum coverage, use a drop spreader, though crank-style broadcast spreaders also work.

Over-seed

A dense lawn not only looks good, but also helps protect against weeds. Over-seeding your existing turf can help fill in any thin or bare spots and also introduces the resilient grass seed. over-seed immediately after aerating when the ground is still warm, nights are cooler and the sun is not as hot during the day.
