What is now known as the World's Biggest Fish Fry began as Mule Day in 1938, when the local custom was for farmers to bring their mules to town on Mondays. The Paris Post-Intelligencer was the sponsor. The event was later managed by the Chamber of Commerce and was taken over by the Paris-Henry County Jaycees in 1961.

Hoping to brand Paris and Henry County as a recreation des-

tination with a three day fish fry, the first event on April 29, 1954, was not successful. The fish were from Mississippi and the food was handled by a caterer from Memphis. Rethinking their plans, local leaders decided the next year to fry the fish downtown, with the assistance of many community clubs, cooking around 1600 pounds the second year. The number of pounds cooked annually presently exceeds five tons.

Now there is an annual Hostess Princess chosen, but until 1972, there was also a Queen of the Tennessee Valley pageant. Suzanne Banta wore both crowns, serving as Hostess Princess in 1966 and Queen of the Tennessee Valley in 1968. Donna Lynn Cody also held both titles. in 1969 as Hostess Princess and 1970 as Queen of the Tennessee Valley.


The Jaycees added the car-

nival to the Fish Fry festivities and many activities have become staples, such as the rodeo and Small Fry Parade, but others have been dropped over the years. There are street dances and Christian music concerts, but the 1966 World's **Biggest Fish** Fry included the "Fish Fry A Go Go," an afternoon of music that included bands such as the Termights and the Shaggy Dogs. It was sponsored by Leach's Music and TV. Other

events which have been part of the festivities over the years but did not make it to our current Fish Fry are husband-calling contests, bowling tournaments and beard growing competitions.

The Jaycettes, an all female organization which worked with the Jaycees, reorganized in Paris in 1963, with six members. The group's first project was to assist with the milk bills at John R. Miller school and pay one child's lunch bill each month. The group also took several children on a shopping

continues today as the annual Jaycee "Shop with a Cop" each December. Nancy Carpenter was the first female General Manager, in 1994.

The Jaycees teen division was the Order of the teen SPOKES at Grove High School. Members included former Tennessee State Representative Don Ridgeway.

The World's Biggest Fish Fry is now heralded as an extraordinary example of volunteerism and community activity and some folks just keeping showing up:

Pam Williams, Hostess Princess in 1979, was queen of the Pre-Teen Court in 1972. Hannah Robison (Pam Williams Robison's daughter) served as Hostess Princess in 2010 and later and Miss Tennessee, where she ranked in the top seven finalists of the Miss America Pageant.

Gary and Janice Benton, publishers of the Peddler Gary and I can't Advantage and past owners of WMUF radio hold the World's Biggest Fish Fry in such high regard and have many cherished memories.

"Not being a native Parisian. say we grew up going to Fish Fry," said Janice. "But our daughter, Jessica, who was four when we moved here did grow up with it. We moved to

Paris in March of 1985, when we bought WMUF radio and jumped into Fish Fry with both feet," said Janice. "It has been a part of us ever since."

Janice said she has so many fond

memories that it is hard to remember them all. She mentions being in the parade or just watching the parade was always fun. "Whether we were covering events for the radio station or the Peddler or

just enjoying the events with our daughter and other family members ... the Fish Fry will always be special."

Gary said he remembered Jessica asking him repeatedly if he had enough tickets for her and her best friend to ride all the rides they wanted. "It seemed like I had 500 tickets, and the girls were so excited." he said. Later, when he went looking for the girls he said he found them being hosed off by one of the workers. "I re-

member thinking 'what in the world." Jessica quickly informed him that her bestie had thrown up all of the goodies they had enjoyed earlier in the day on their last ride.

Janice said her mother loved to visit during Fish Fry. "Fried catfish was her all time favorite food. She would tell the server 'I want it fried dark and crisp." She remembers serving catfish with her mother on the late shift one year. "We were trying to clean tables and this

one cowboy kept going back for more fish. Mom said to him, 'you love fish almost as much as I do!"

Janice's mom. Angie, is no longer with us and Jessica is now married, an attorney and living in Memphis with her husband and baby, Jack. But Gary and Janice are extremely grateful for their Fish Fry memories. "We have so many good fish fry memories over the years and so many more to make with our grandson, Jack."

That's why they call it the WORLD'S BIGGEST FISH FRY written by: Teresa Jones

The year 2020 will go down in the history of the World's Biggest Fish Fry. Unfortunately, the festivities were cancelled for the first time since it's onset due to the deadly Coronavirus. Anyone who lives in or near Henry County, TN knows to mark their calendar for the last full weekend in April. Most folks in the area consider it a holiday week. The perfect week for family reunions, homecomings, parades, beauty contests, carnival, catfish races and the list goes on. The main attraction though, is the Fish Fry itself. The sounds of crack-

ling kettles, laughter and conversations fill the tent. The smells of fresh cooked catfish and all the fixin's drift out of the fish tent tempting hungry crowds to hurry and get in line. Inside patrons are always met with smiles and kindness. Everyone just seems to enjoy seeing neighbors or old friends. It is a great meeting place for people from all over the country to enjoy just what Henry County, TN is all about. Community. Sadly, this year the tent was silent.

What is known as The World's Biggest Fish Fry actually began as "Mule Day" in 1938. It wasn't until 1953 the name changed to "The Fish Fry" where fish was cooked for the first time at the event. The cooking was done outdoors and people ate at picnic tables under a big tent. The first years about 1,000 pounds of fish were served. In 2019, over 12,000 pounds of catfish fillets were cooked and served to hungry crowds. Of





the 8 original black iron pots used to cook the fish, 7 of the kettles are still being used today. There are 8 fish cooks that rotate cooking only catfish. The Buchanan Masonic Lodge prepares all the hushpuppies. Springville Community Group is in charge of the white beans. The 18 to 24 thousand pounds of vinegar cole slaw is made fresh on site. In 1985 it became tradition the Hostess Princess tosses out the first hushpuppies to signify the official opening of the fish tent.

David "Tater" Hayes began assisting Bobby Cox, former Jaycee Chair-

man, at the fish tent in 1985. David took charge of the fish tent when Bobby fell ill. Hayes now serves as Jaycee chairman of the tent. After Cox's passing in 1994, the fish tent was officially named in his honor. It is now known as "The Bobby Cox Memorial Fish Tent". As an inspiration to all who volunteer, his hat and apron are proudly hung for all to see and remember him. It takes many cooks and volunteers to make the fish tent so successful each year. Hopefully, 2021 will bring better days. The fish tent was missed this year by so many. It really is the highlight of The World's Biggest Fish Fry!



What is the mental image that comes to mind when you hear the words "World's Biggest Fish Fry"? Is it a Hostess Princess tossing the first hush puppy to her daddy to open the fish tent? Is it thousands of people lining the streets to see the Grand Parade? Do you immediately think of the Small Fry parade or the Catfish Races?

Sponsored by the Paris-Henry County Jaycees, the World's Biggest Fish Fry has evolved from a community festival into something more. Former General Manager Dwayne Baldwin, Walker's Pre-Owned Vehicles, says "Somewhere along the line, it became a time of homecoming and family reunions." The Fish Fry is also a source of pride for Paris and Henry County, the kickoff of the festival season in West Tennessee and the unofficial sign that spring has arrived.

Baldwin has the distinction of being both the youngest and oldest General Manager of the event, having served in both 1978 and 2001. When asked if he would sign up to be charge again, he said "I might have to do it from a scooter!" Despite having taken the GM role twice, Baldwin is best known as the chairman of the Grand Parade. He is even rumored to have strange powers over rain. He recalls that in all his years lining up the parade, over three different routes, there has only been on true rain out event. He says "It has rained before and after, but it has only rained out once, when Lamar Alexander was Governor of Tennessee."

Baldwin's obvious pride in the event, and its impact on his community, comes through his voice when he talks about the "first boom on a drum" every year and the friendship he developed with former Governor Ned Ray McWherter, who was a tremendous Fish Fry supporter.

Contrasting Dwayne Baldwin's years of experience, Anna Walla, a customer service representative at Land Between the Lakes National Recreation Area, has only been an official member of Jaycees since 2018. She was drawn to the organization because of the opportunity it gave her to contribute to the community and help out. She is a former co-chair of the Kids Fishing Rodeo and says "The kids make it. Sometimes that's their very first fish!"

Despite being fairly new to the festivities she feels that the local Jaycees chapter are "kind of like family now."

A family filled with special Fish Fry memories is the Robisons from






says the Jaycees "just scooped me up like a child or a little sister."

county that continue to be friends." Pam's daughter, Hannah Robison Shellnut, was crowned Hostess Princess thirty-one years later and recalled the photo shoots as well.

She says that her "sweetest memory" from serving as ambassador of the Fish Fry was the time she got to share with her mother, saying "She got to go with me to the businesses and people remembered her."

Hannah loves that so much of the Fish Fry stays the same from year to year, citing those traditions as one of the hallmarks of the event. One of her favorite photos from her year is "one of me with my dad" tossing the hushpuppy.

Dwayne Baldwin's standout moment was a Fish Fry occurrence that completely represents his years managing the Grand Parade. Baldwin remembers a moment just before releasing the parade. The Budweiser Clydesdales' noses were pressed against his shoulder blades as the crowd looked up to the sky to see a squad of Air Force A-10 Warthog jets fly over the parade. "I kinda got weak-kneed."


Dur Hostes Princess may she ever resen





The financial impact of the World's Biggest Fish Fry on our community Written by: Travis McCleese, Director of the Paris/Henry County Chamber of Commerce

The World's Biggest Fish Fry has been a staple in this region for decades, and for the first time in its 67 years, it was canceled mid-year due to Covid-19. Like the Strawberry Festival, The Tennessee River Jam, and the Soybean Festival, The World's Biggest Fish Fry not only created memorable events that entertained patrons and enriched communities, but served as major economic drivers for their communities.

In 2018, Henry County collected 58.6 million in tourism revenue saving local tax payers an estimated \$804 per year on their state and local taxes. That portfolio includes a variety of tourism assets that produce revenue, but arguably, one of most popular events is the Fish Fry.

Guests visit our community from across the country to get a taste of what the week-long celebration provides. With those guests, comes significant revenue for our county. It is easy to assume the obvious recipients of that revenue; hotels, restaurants, gas stations, advertisers etc., but most will overlook the secondary organizations and nonprofits affected.

Take the Downtown Paris Association for example. According to Kathy Ray, Executive Director of the Downtown Paris Association, the selling of fish beads brings their organization over \$1,500 that benefits their mission. Other organizations rely on parking cars, parade day revenue, and other miscellaneous projects that raise money.

It is nearly impossible to get a concrete number on the total financial impact that Fish Fry makes because of its length and the number of industries it affects, but some estimates could show over a \$2,000,000 impact for the community. Of course, weather plays a major role in that number as well.

Looking forward, it is important for us, as a community, to give the Jaycees as much support as we can through man power and sponsorship dollars to help see this event continue to prosper. Those volunteers work tirelessly to produce this event, many of them taking their vacation time to volunteer.

Needless to say, we look forward to the next World's Biggest Fish Fry being bigger and better than ever!

Nancy Carpenter made World's Biggest Fish Fry history when she was elected the first female General Manager in 1994. The word "Superwoman" has been used many times to describe her. She is a mother, grandmother, friend and Jaycee.

According to WBFF history books, Nancy was a charter member of the Tullahoma Jaycettes in 1975.

She joined the **Henry County** Jaycees in 1989. In her Jaycee career leading up to being General Manager, Nancy served as the Chapter Management Vice President (1989), Headquarters Secretary (1989-1992), secretary of the Fish Fry Board (1991), coordinator of the Jr. King and Queen Pageant (1989), coordinator of the Hostess **Princess Pageant** (1990-1993), and

coordinator of the Miss Pre-Teen Pageant (1992).

Nancy's awards and honors include the 1992 Presidential Award of Excellence and she was named The Jaycee of the Year in 1993. Nancy was always known as a devoted Jaycee that contributed immensely to her community.

In the 67 year history of the Fish Fry only six women have served as General Manager. Nancy Carpenter was the first, leading the way for Toni Kaye Bowden, Cecilia Casey, Andrea Lamb, Lisa Stone and three time General Manager, Loria Plunk.

All General Managers have put forth a tremendous amount of effort coordinating the World's Biggest Fish Fry. It has never been and never will be an easy task to pull together this huge event. It takes a strong leader and lots of volunteer hours to get the job done. All of the men and women of the Jaycees have made Henry County proud.
