Recently I've noticed that people are buying used boats, motors and trailers and are not having them checked out by a professional or

closely inspecting the items themselves. This can result in costing a person a whole lot of money. You should do this just like you do when

you purchase a car. You could save yourself a lot of time, effort and dollars by taking the boat, motor and trailer to a shop in your neighborhood and have it checked out.

A few things that a person can do on his own is to check out the trailer by just jacking up the wheels and

spinning the tires. Listen for noisy bearings in the wheels. Also, make sure the wench works properly. Have them hook up the lights to make sure they work and make note of any visible signs of rust.

When checking out the boat, take a piece of hard plastic or a small

hammer and tap on the transom. If it has a hollow sound to it that means the transom is bad and that is a very expensive repair. A good transom has a solid sound when tapped on. Check the floor for soft spots. A soft spot means the floor is worn out and that, also, can be a costly repair.

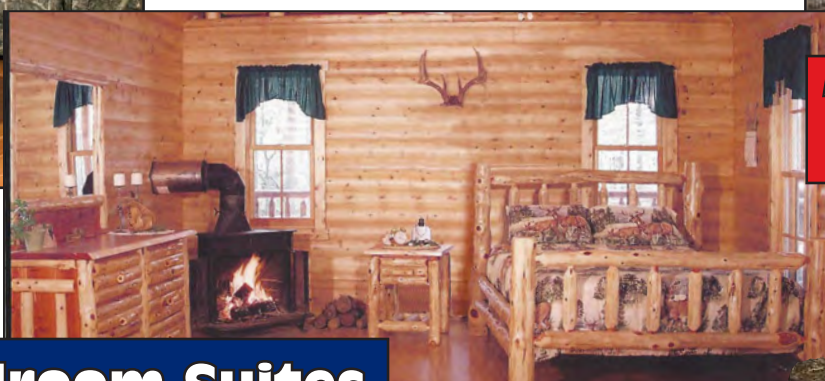

# HAVE YOU

The beautiful 841 acre **Paris Landing State Park**, founded in 1945 is located about 15 miles from Paris on Kentucky Lake's western shore. It's name was taken from the 1880's steamboat and freight landing that once served as a shipping point for the region. The park features pavilions, cabins, swimming pool, playgrounds, tennis courts, campgrounds, golf course, marina and access to numerous boating, fishing and water activities.



The **Paris Landing Inn**, features 100 rooms with balconies overlooking Kentucky Lake, gift shops and the Riverboat Restaurant which is noted for its excellent buffet of delicious catfish and other southern cuisine. The restaurant serves people and has massive views of the lake. Information can be obtained by phone at 731-641-4465 or [tnstateparks.com/paris-landing](http://tnstateparks.com/paris-landing).



**Fort Donalson** is a MUST SEE! General Ulysses S. Grant, upon the surrender of Confederate Fort Donalson wrote; "Fort Donalson will hereafter be marked in Capitals on the map of our United Country...". The Union victory at Fort Donalson changed the course of the Civil War. Visitors to the Fort will be amazed at the history contained within the 6-mile self guided tour of the Battlefield and visitor center. The handicap accessible and child friendly Visitor Center is open 8 am to 4:30 pm daily and contains a bookstore, museum, Civil War artifacts and various exhibits exploring the Civil War. Located 120 Fort Donalson Shores Road, Dover, TN phone: 931-232-5706. The first bridge across the Tennessee River at Paris Landing was constructed between 1927 and 1929. The state authorized \$1,029,390.66 to build a bridge north of the Sandy River near Fort Henry. Originally built as a toll bridge connecting Henry County to Stewart County, state employees lived in a toll house near the bridge to collect the fares. Since the tolls did not generate enough revenue to offset the costs of the toll employee and pay the anticipated 2% cost of the bridge, tolls were removed in 1947. Around 1948 when Kentucky Dam caused water levels to rise, the Paris Landing Bridge was vertically extended to increase it's height. It was then named The Scott Fitzhugh Bridge in honor of a former Speaker of the House from Paris. The bridge was considered unusually large in scale and contained more truss spans than any bridge in Tennessee. This bridge was demolished in 1989 and the new 4,734 foot long, 20 feet wide roadway was opened in 1992. At this time the bridge was re-named **The Ned Ray McWherter Bridge** in honor of the governor who served Tennessee from 1987 to 1985 and was a resident of Henry County. A section of the original bridge now serves as a memorial display at the Paris Landing State Park's Marina.

The prairie is open year round and has a \$5 entry fee. This is a very enjoyable leisurely way to witness nature at it's best.



**Hazel, Ky** is located on the TN/KY state line between Paris, TN and Murray, KY on Highway 641. Founded in 1880 as a rail center, today this charming and unique town is a shoppers dream come true. Visitors can spend a leisurely day searching for that one of a kind special something in any of Main Street's 12 antique shops and dine in one of the town's unique restaurants. March 23 is Hazel's annual Spring Fling and the first week of June, Hazel participates in the 400 mile historic 68/80/641 South Yard Sale. On the 3rd Saturday of September, the town hosts The Hazel Celebration with parades, flea markets, music, antiques and more.
