Paris, TN - The 9th Annual Ice Cream Social & Antique Car & Tractor Show will fill historic downtown Paris on the last Saturday in July, July 28th, from 4:00 – 6:30 pm. Sponsored by the Downtown Paris Association (DPA), the event benefits the Downtown Paris Association and the Historic Atkins Porter Neighborhood Association.

"This has become an end-of-summer tradition that folks of all ages look forward to," said DPA Executive Director Kathy Ray.

"Everyone with an event wristband can enjoy free ice cream from each booth, kids' bouncers, giant slides, and crazy contests; it's definitely the coolest fundraiser around, no pun intended." Wristbands are available for a minimum donation of \$10 for adults or \$5 for children 12 and under. The Antique Car Show brings ve-

hicles in from four states and there will be 80 to 90 classic cars, according to Chairperson Vicky Muzzall. Registration is a minimum donation of \$10 which includes an event wristband. 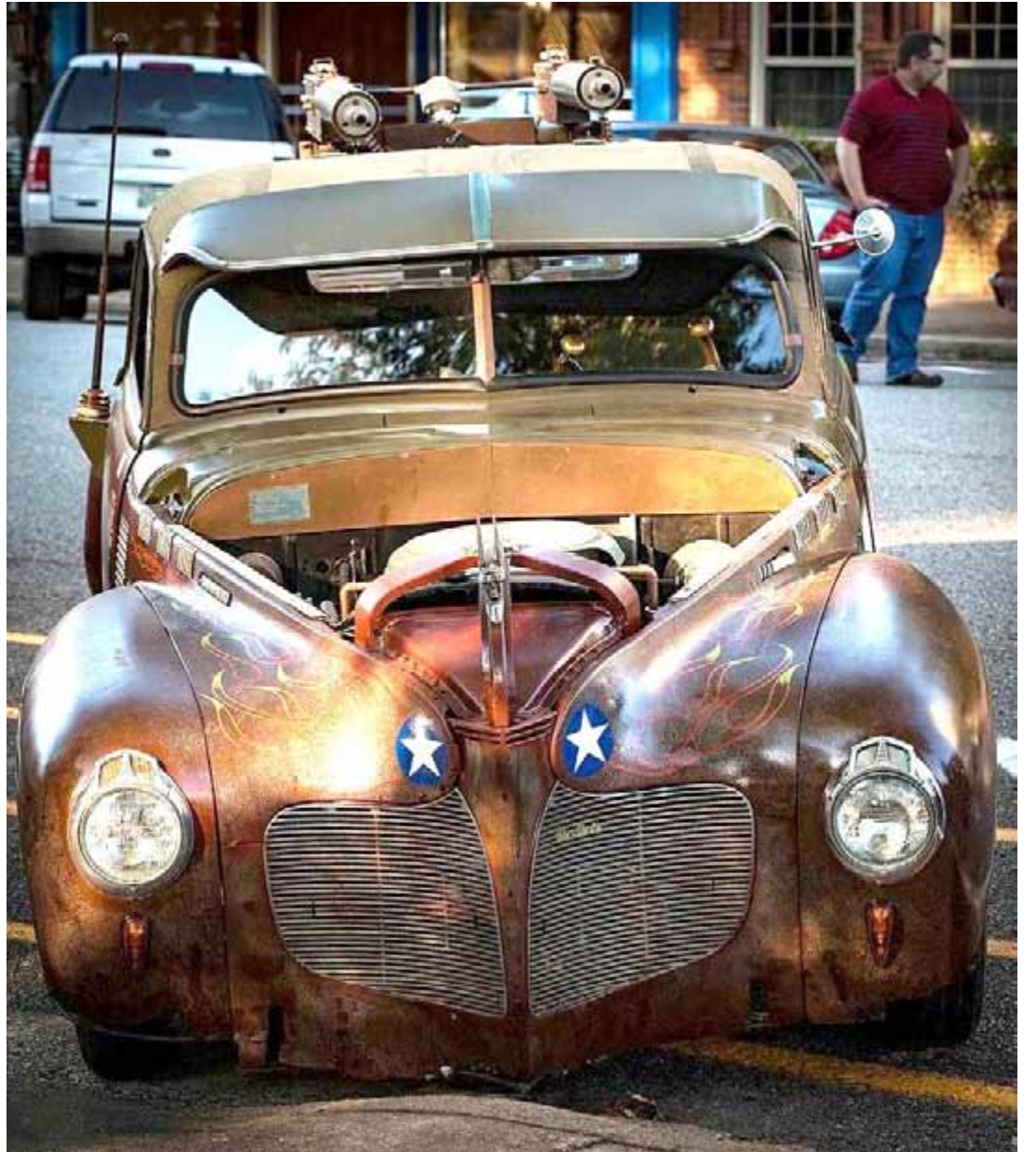



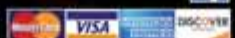
