It just wouldn't be summer time in Northwest Tennessee without a visit to the lake! We are fortunate that we have so many lakes to choose from in our area. All of them are stocked and ready for fishing. And nothing takes the sizzle off a hot summer day like a dip in the cool water or a relaxing boat ride!

There are a few lakes in our area that are just so magnificent they need a special shout out! Like the Carroll County Thousand Acre Recreation Lake. Take Boyd's Landing Road in Huntingdon, Tennessee to one of the main entry ways to the lake parking

areas. The Thousand Acre Lake is a newer man made area built specifically for recreation of all sorts. There are boat ramps for easy access to the water. So it is a great place to spend the day fishing, or skiing or just boating leisurely around the lake.

Conveniently the lake is divided into two areas. Two thirds of the lake is dedicated to skiing and boating and jet skiing and one third is for fishing. If you want to take the risk, fishing is also permitted in the sporting area as well as from the shore. There are designated swimming areas, too.

Around the lake you will find beaches, picnic tables, pavilions, restrooms and concessions. If you are into RV camping there is also a RV park located at the lake with electricity and water available.

Reelfoot Lake covers 15,000 acres and is the largest naturally occurring lake in the state of Tennessee. It is located in Lake and tive sites available **Obion Counties** in the Northwest part of the state. Reelfoot Lake is a huge attraction for that area. It is not only a boater's paradise but a great place for hunting as Kentucky Lake is well. Reelfoot Lake State Park features all the amenities you would want

to find when you wanting to spend the day outside but necessarily wanting to rough it. There are boat ramps and beaches, picnic areas and restrooms. The State Park features events like one of the largest arts and craft's festivals in West Tennessee. They also hold duck blind drawings and a waterfowl festival here, too. You can camp on the primior rent one of the rustic cabins. The Reelfoot Lake State Park office is located at 2595 Hwy 21E, Tiptonville, Tennessee.

nearly 160,300 acres, with more than 2,400 miles of shoreline. The lake itself is located in counties in Western Kentucky, Western and Middle Tennessee. It is surrounded by four state parks, two county parks and five municipal parks. The wildlife also love to live around





Being under quarantine can get old really quick. When your family is ready for an adventure they won't soon forget, we know just the place you need to go... the Tennessee Safari Park, in Alamo. The Safari Park has more than 400 domestic and exotic animals waiting for you to come and visit.

Besides your native animals to West Tennessee, like goats, rabbits, pigs and ponies you will also see exotic animals from far away lands. The Safari Park has

one of the largest collection of animals in the United States.

The Tennessee Sa-

fari Park is actually two different experiences. There is a Petting Zoo and a two mile Driving Tour. It is the only place in West Tennessee that you can drive-thru and see zebras, llamas, emus, giraffes, kangaroos, warthogs and monkeys. The exciting thing about the driving tour is that you can purchase buckets of food and feed them right from you automobile. The animals will come

right up to your car. Safari Park. Don't be surprised if they stick their heads in the window, they can be pretty hungry some times. Because of consideration for the animal's health, the park asks that no outside food be fed to the animals.

The Petting Zoo is where you can get up close and personal with the animals. You get to walk among the more domesticated animals and pet and feed them. A family would have to travel hours to Memphis or Nashville to see animals like the ones at the

According to the Trip Savvy Visitor's Guide there are some things you should take into consideration before attending the Safari Park. The cost is \$16 per adult and \$12 for children ages 3 to 12. You can purchase small buckets of feed for \$3 each or get a deal of 4 buckets for \$10. The Safari Park takes cash only, they do not accept credit or debit cards.







"Personal Classifieds" are \$10.00 for 4 weeks, 20 words or less.



Depending on attendance you should plan to spend any where from one to two hours at the Safari Park. They suggest that the best time to attend is in the morning hours. The animals tend to be more hungry during the morn-

ing hours and are likely to be more engaging with the visitors.

Do not bring animals from home to the Safari Park. This is important due to the fact that animals from home can agitate the animals in the park.

The Tennessee
Safari Park is open
every day of the
year, with the exception of Thanksgiving, Christmas
Eve, and Christmas
Day. The hours of
operation are Monday thru Saturday,
10am to 4pm (the
last time of day
cars are permit-

ted in the park). The park closes completely at 5pm. Sunday hours are noon to 4pm with same admittance policy for cars.

A visit to the Tennessee Safari Park in Alamo will not be a trip you will soon forget. You



Patsy Cline Forever Remembered at Memorial Site in Camden




Patsy Cline will always be remembered as one of traditional country music's all time great artists. She will also be remembered as being taken from the stage way before she was ever able to reach her prime. A tragic plane crash on the morning of March


5th, 1963 took the life of Patsy, along with country music stars Cowby Copas, Hawkshaw Hawkins and pilot, Randy Hughes. That plane crashed in the woods of Camden, Tennessee.

The Benton County Chamber of Commerce, along with the work of private citizens and area civic groups, have over the years, made a memorial out of the spot where that plane went down. Great strides have been made recently to make the spot more accessible to the public. It is a short walk to the memorial site and at this time is not completely handicap accessible. Things to keep in mind if you are planning on visiting.

The Patsy Cline Memorial is located at 2904 Mt. Carmel Road, in Camden, Tennessee. A sign to the right side of the road indicates the pathway that leads down to the Memorial Boulder. Take

The Paris Civic Center, located at 650 Volunteer Drive is open for workouts and swimming as well. GRILLED CHICKEN SALAD SANDWICH

1 cup mayonnaise 1/8 teaspoon ground black pepper 1/8 teaspoon garlic

powder 1/8 teaspoon celery

- 4 cups chopped leftover grilled chicken
- 2 celery stalks, sliced
- ½ cup sweetened dried cranberries
- 2/3 cup salted cashews
- 8 slices bread, toasted
- 4 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 4 large red leaf lettuce leaves 1 ripe tomato,

- 1 (2 ounce) jar diced pimentos, drained
- 1 medium sweet gherkin pickle, diced
- 34 cup creamy salad dressing
- 2 tablespoons prepared yellow mustard
- 3 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- 1/3 cup white sugar *CASSEROLE*
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3 hard-cooked eggs, chopped

Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Place macaroni in the pot, and cook for 8 to 10 minutes, or until al dente. Drain and rinse under cold water. In a large bowl, mix the macaroni, celery, sweet onion, pimentos, and pickle. In a separate bowl, mix the creamy salad dressing, mustard, vinegar, sugar, and salt. Stir dressing into the macaroni mixture. Fold in the eggs. Chill in the refrigerator at least 2 hours before serving.

SQUASH

½ cup butter 4 yellow summer squash, thinly sliced

- 1 small yellow onion, thinly sliced
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 1 cup shredded sharp Cheddar cheese
- 1 sleeve buttery round crackers



(such as Ritz®), crushed and divided ¼ cup melted butter

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease a 1-quart baking dish. Melt 1/4 cup butter in a saucepan over medium heat. Cook and stir squash and onion in hot butter until tender, 10 to 15 minutes. Drain and cool vegetables. Whisk sour cream and egg together in a large bowl. Add squash mixture, Cheddar cheese, and 1/2 of the crushed buttery round crackers; stir to combine and pour into prepared baking dish. Stir remaining buttery round crackers and melted butter together in a bowl; spread over the top of squash mixture and gently pat down. Bake in the preheated oven until crackers are lightly browned, about 20 minutes.

GRILLED SALMON

1½ pounds salmon fillets

½ teaspoon lemon pepper to taste

1/4 teaspoon garlic powder to taste

½ teaspoon salt to taste 1/3 cup soy sauce 1/3 cup brown sugar 1/3 cup water ½ cup vegetable oil

Season salmon fillets with lemon pepper, garlic powder, and salt. In a small bowl, stir together soy sauce, brown sugar, water, and vegetable oil until sugar is dissolved. Place fish in a large resealable plastic bag with the soy sauce mixture, seal, and turn to coat. Refrigerate for at least 2 hours. Preheat grill for medium heat. Lightly oil grill grate. Place salmon on the preheated grill, and discard marinade. Cook salmon for 6 to 8 minutes per side, or until the fish flakes easily with a fork.

MEATLOAF

1½ pounds ground beef

1 egg

1 onion, chopped

1 cup milk

1 cup dried bread crumbs salt and pepper to

taste
2 tablespoons
brown sugar

2 tablespoons prepared mustard





1/3 cup ketchup

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a large bowl, combine the beef, egg, onion, milk and bread OR cracker crumbs. Season with salt and pepper to taste and place in a lightly greased 5x9 inch loaf pan, OR form into a loaf and place in a lightly greased 9x13 inch baking dish. In a separate small bowl, combine the brown sugar, mustard and ketchup. Mix well and pour over the meatloaf. Bake at 350 degrees F for 1 hour.



The ferry has become a very


