An event in north-west Tennessee just isn't official until the first pageant has been held. The Henry County Fair will continue with that tradition with several pageants recognizing many different age groups.

The Miss Preteen Pageant kicks-off the contests on Saturday, August 7th, at 3:30pm on the stage at the Commercial Building at the Fairgrounds. This contest is for young women ages 10, 11 and 12 years

old. There will be a \$5 admission fee. Beginning at 5pm will be the Miss Teen Pageant. This contest is for young women ages 13, 14 and 15 years old. The admission for this pageant is \$5 at the Commercial Building. The Main Event will begin at 6:30pm – The Fairest of the Fair. Young ladies must be between the ages of 16 and 20 years old to participate. The winner of this contest will represent Henry County in the state-wide Fairest

of the Fair Pageant. Henry County has had several winners at the state level.

The contests for the younger children will all be held on Sunday, August 8th in the Commercial Building at the Fairgrounds. Admission into these shows is \$5 or a donation of 2 cans of food. The Little Miss contest will begin at 2pm. It is open to children ages 4, 5 and 6 years old. The Jr. Miss Pageant begins at 2:45 pm and is open to

young ladies that are 7, 8 and 9 years old. The Baby Barn Yard Pageants pretty much cover everyone else from birth to 3 years old. That contest gets underway at 3:30pm.

Horticulturalists, Artisans and Kitchen Crafters prepare and plan projects all year long for the exhibits at the Henry County Fair. During the week of the fair, the rest of us get to admire their handiwork and see who takes home the top prizes. The Henry County Fair has two types of exhibit venues. The exhibits in the Community Building are the canned goods, art work, baked goods, flowers and plants. The Commercial Building exhibits will be exhibits by local businesses, churches and civic organizations. These exhibits may also feature items for sale or small giveaways.

The Community Building will open at 11am, Monday, August 9th, to start taking Adult Department and Youth Department Entries. It will continue to receive entries until 6pm. Also, during this time the Adult and Youth Horticulture

and Field Crop entries will be accepted.

The Community Building will be closed from 9:30am til noon, Tuesday, August 10th, for the judging of the Adult and Youth Horticulture and Field Crop submissions. Viewing for all entries will be at 2pm on Tuesday. The Community Building will remain open until 8pm.

The exhibits in the Community Building will be on exhibit during the Chamber Coffee from 8 to 9am, Wednesday, August 11th. Flower Basket entries will be accepted beginning at 9am until 11am at the Community Building. It will immediately be followed by judging and the exhibits will be closed. After judging the Community Building will reopen. The Community Building will open again at 5pm for the exhibits that are there.

The Community Building will be open all day, 9am-9pm on Thursday, August 12th. The Commercial Building exhibits will be open from 5 to 8:30pm. The Community Building will be open from noon on Friday, August 13th, until 9pm. The Commercial Building will open at 5pm on both Friday and Saturday, August 14th.

All exhibits need to be dismantled and removed on Sunday afternoon, between 12:30 – 1:30pm. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to remove their submissions. Also, prizes

and giveaways need to be collected or arranged to be collected before then.

Enjoy the return of your Henry County Fair and the exhibits in two buildings. Support your local businesses, organization and citizens by visiting all of the Shows sponsored by the Fair. Don't forget this year's fair has free parking and no charge for gate admission.
