of the Fair Pageant. Henry County has had several winners at the state level.



Remember this years Fair will have free parking and gate admission.







After judging the Community Building will reopen. The Community Building will open again at 5pm for the exhibits that are

there.

The Community Building will be open all day, 9am-9pm on Thursday, August 12th.The Commercial Building exhibits will be open from 5 to 8:30pm. The Community Building will be open from noon on Friday, August 13th, until 9pm. The Commercial Building will open at 5pm on both Friday and Saturday, August 14th.

All exhibits need to be dismantled and removed on Sunday afternoon, between 12:30 – 1:30pm. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to remove their submissions. Also, prizes

and giveaways need to be collected or arranged to be collected before then.




Dixie Bennett is the daughter of Ty and Dawn

spent involved with the HC Fair Jr Livestock Show




