The best place to spot Aquaman in Henry County this weekend will probably be at the Paris Henry County Chamber of Commerce's Water Fun Run! Super Heroes are the theme and super fun will be the big thing. Fans of a fun and unique Poker Run gather at Paris Landing on the third Saturday of July to participate year after year!

Participants must pick up a Water Fun Run Packet, either at the Chamber of Commerce in advance or at one of the Water Run destinations. Packets are available now and cost \$20. On Water Run day they are only available at the lake and

the charge is \$25. Also, keep in mind, t-shirts sell out fast. They have become a cherished collector's item. You definitely want to buy one in advance.

All Poker Runs are fun but what makes this one unique is that it is played on the water. You visit destinations located around Kentucky Lake by pontoon, ski boat, jet ski or even a canoe if you choose. The destinations are comprised of the resorts and dock bars and restaurants located around our favorite water spot. At these different stops you will get a stamp on your official Play Sheet that is available in your Water Fun Run Packet.

When you return to your final destination, which is always the Marina at Paris Landing, you check in with the dealers. Everyone receives a playing card for each stamp you collected on your run around the lake. Sometimes you can collect as many as nine stamps so you would be eligible for nine cards. A poker guru will help you pick out five of those cards to create your best hand. If you end up with the winning hand you take home cold hard cash!

The Water Fun Run always has amazing cash prizes and lots of chances to win! Wild and crazy themes are

always a big part of the Water Run, too. Past themes have included Red Neck Yacht Club and Cheeseburgers in Paris-dise. This year's amazing theme is Super Heroes! Expect to see lots of capes and swim trunks and bikinis!

This is usually one of the last big events on Kentucky Lake during the summer season so you don't want to miss it. Who's Hungry?
The First Presbyterian Church of Paris asks that question every first Thursday of the month. That is the night that they have Shepherd's Table, a free take out meal, open to anyone that might be hungry. No matter if you can't afford to eat out or just don't feel like cooking, The members of the First Presbyterian want to bless you.

Every month there is a full menu for supper with a main entree, sides and dessert. Some of

their most popular meals in the past have been turkey and homemade dressing, bar-be-que sandwiches, meatloaf and mashed potatoes and stuffed peppers. Most of the meals are served with a side of veggies or a salad, a roll or cornbread and a delicious dessert of homemade brownies or cookies.

Participation in Shepherd's Table is easy. All you have to do is show up. You don't even have to get out of your car. Right

now, the church is doing a curb side service. You just drive up and tell us how many you need. We bring them to you. Nothing to sign up for, no ID required. We just ask that you be hungry.

The First Presbyterian Church of Paris is located next to the Post Office in downtown Paris, 105 S. Market Street. The church requests that you park on the Blythe Street side of the church and make your dinner requests. Shepherd's Table begins

serving at 4:30 pm and continues until they either run out of food or 6:30pm. It is first come first served and no reservations.

Put on your calendar the following dates: August 4th, September 1st, October 6th, November 3rd and December 1st. These are the nights Shepherd's Table will be serving for the rest of the year. The members and volunteers at First Presbyterian Church and Pastor Tommy Taylor say, "Everyone is invited!"

Take a Ride on the Wild Side at the Safari Park

The Tennessee Safari Park, 618 Conley Road, in Alamo, Tennessee, uses the phrase “Small Town, Big Safari”. It’s definitely true, with so many animal to see, right here in West Tennessee.

So what can you expect? Africa at your back door! Species now living

in Alamo include addax, addra gazelle, alpaca, axis deer, Bactrian camel, bison, emu, giraffe, wildebeest and zebu, just to name a few, and that’s just in the 7.5 mile drive through. You can also walk through to see lemur, Nigerian dwarf goat, squirrel monkey and watusi! The park

advises an hour for the drive through experience and at least as much for the walk through, so schedule two hours or more.

The USDA Land Between the Lakes National Recreation Area is an extraordinary attraction in Kentucky and Tennessee. The 178,000 acre facility includes an Elk and Bison Prairie, the 1850s Homeplace,

Woodlands Nature Station and Golden Pond Planetarium and Observatory.

The planetarium is managed by the Friends of Land Between the Lakes and offers a variety of entertaining and educational pro-

grams with the Sky Explorer Digital software and a 2k laser projector which displays on a 40 foot dome. Facility manager Bill Futrell in a blog post mentioned that the new projection systems offers bright colors and outstanding blending, a powerful light source, precise outlines and an exceptional starry sky rendering.

Shows, which focus on astronomy and earth science, begin at 10 am daily and are offered hourly until 4 pm. Titles include “Laser Legends of the Night Sky,” “Earth, Moon and Sun,” “Traveling with Light,” and “Discover the Stars.” Cost for planetarium shows is \$7 for ages 13 and up \$4.50 for ages 5-12, under 4 is free. The shows average 40 minutes.

The observatory is a partnership be-

tween the Friends of Land Between the Lakes and West Kentucky Amateur Astronomers. It is open select Saturdays and features the computerized Meade 16 inch Schmidt-Cassegrain Telescope.

Laser shows are played at 5:30 pm and 7 pm on Tuesday, Fridays and Saturdays, with additional 8 pm shows on Saturdays. Offerings include “Laser Beatles,” “Laser U2,” “Laser Queen” and “Laser Metallica”. Cost is \$8.

Golden Pond Planetarium is located at 238 Visitor Drive, Golden Pond, KY 42211. For more information, call 270.924.2233 or visit www.land-betweenthe lakes.us. The facility is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Years Day.

One online reviewer called it a "great park for the family and fur babies!!"

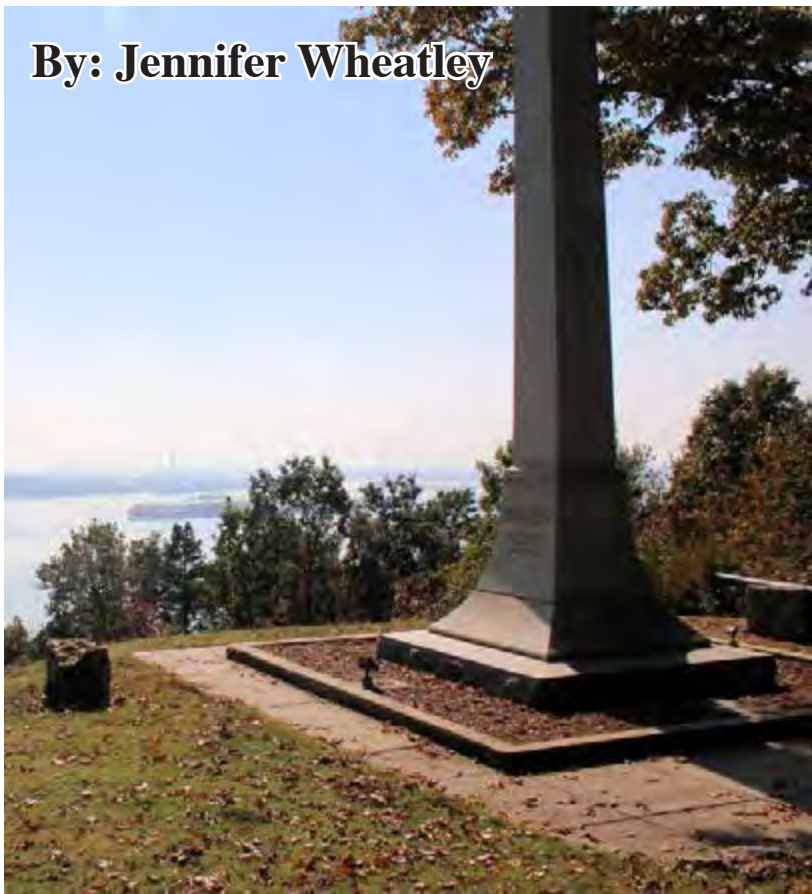
The Bring Fido website says "This park is very spacious! Lots of room for your pup to run

Eiffel Tower Park (formerly Memorial Park) in Paris, Tennessee, has evolved over the years from a welcoming green space to one of the premier city parks in West Tennessee. The location of a

wooden small scale Eiffel Tower, no longer needed for Memphis in May, began the transformation. A group of local concerned citizens raised funds to install sturdy, colorful plastic playground

equipment. Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Tennessee has added a play facility.

The tower was eventually replaced by a 66 foot steel version which is now lit to serve as one of the community's most outstanding public relations tools, bringing attention to breast

cancer awareness, a holiday or a special cause. A surrounding brick wall, excellent for photo ops, was built by the local Lowes.

The Bargain Highway, Benton County's 30 miles of yard sales planned every Labor Day weekend, which is September 2 and 3 this year, by the Benton County/Camden Chamber of Commerce, has been bringing thousands of tourists to the area for years. The event suffered under the Covid 19 pandemic. It was cancelled in 2020 and the number of visitors was still down in 2021, but the Chamber has a new, energetic executive director, Lorie Matlock, and she intends for 2022 to be a big return for the event.
