



#### Cherry Dump Pudding Cake

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup white sugar
- ½ cup butter 1 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4 cups pitted sour cherries 2 cup white sugar
- 1/4 cups cherry juice

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Grease a 10x10-inch baking dish. In large bowl, combine flour, salt, baking powder and 1 cup sugar; stir. Add butter, milk and vanilla; beat with electric mixer for 2 minutes, or until smooth. Pour mixture into pan and cover evenly with cherries. Heat cherry uice in microwave or in small saucepan, until just simmering. Sprinkle 1/2 cup of sugar over cherries, and pour hot cherry juice on top. Bake 40 to 45 minutes, or until pick inserted in center

#### Parmesan Brussels Sprouts

- 1 tablespoon butter
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 6 Brussels sprouts, trimmed and halved
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 2 tablespoons shredded Parmesan cheese salt and ground black pepper to taste
- Heat a frying pan over medium heat until hot, 3 minutes. Melt 1 tablespoon butter; cook and stir garlic until fragrant, 30 seconds. Add 1 tablespoon butter and Brussels sprouts, cut-side down; cover and cook until golden brown, 4 to 6 minutes. Flip Brussels sprouts; add 1 tablespoon butter. Cover and cook until other side is browned, about 3 more minutes. Transfer to a serving plate. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese, salt, and black pepper



#### Baked Pork Chops in Mushroom Sauce

- (4 ounce) pork loin chops
- olive oil cooking spray
- teaspoon garlic powder
- teaspoon paprika
- teaspoon chili powder (26.5 ounce) can condensed cream
- of mushroom soup (14.5 ounce) can diced tomatoes
- medium sweet onion, thinly sliced



Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Heat a cast iron skillet over mediumhigh heat. Spray pork chops with cooking spray and season with garlic powder, paprika, and chili powder. Brown chops in the hot skillet, turning requently, until lightly browned on both sides, 5 to 8 minutes total. Transfer to a casserole or baking dish. Mix mushroom soup and diced tomatoes ogether in a large bowl. Pour over pork chops and place onion slices on top. Cover the pan tightly with aluminum foil. Bake in the preheated oven for 40 minutes. Remove foil and continue to bake until pork is tender, 5 to 10 minutes. An instant-read thermometer inserted into the center should read at least 145 degrees F.
